Standard of Care

Treatment that is accepted by medical experts as a proper treatment for a certain type of disease and that is widely used by healthcare professionals.

A Standard of Care also includes frequent vital sign checks, pain evaluations, gathering and verifying information about health history, frequent verification of patient name, condition/symptoms, medication as well as other components
